Solar Round Decking Light



User Guide

Thank you for choosing The Solar Centre's Round Decking Light. Please read these instructions carefully before installing your light.

Installing your Solar Round Decking Light

Before you take the time to recess your light it is important to think about the amount of light it will receive each day. Position the light in an area that gets good sunlight which is not obstructed by trees, foliage, buildings, fences or the shadows that these create. For best results mount the light horizontally. Failure to do this could result in you making alterations to your decking or patio for a light that will <u>not</u> work well in that location.

- 1: Create a 97mm diameter round hole.
- 2: Put the light into the hole and mark around the lugs.
- 3: Remove light and cut around your marks.
- 4: Unscrew the three screws on the top of the light.
- 5: Remove the stainless steel top (a).
- 6: Remove the plastic insert (b).
- 7: Turn insert upside down and push button to turn on.
- 8: Fix the base (c) into the hole.
- 9: Replace the plastic insert.
- 10: Replace the stainless steel top.
- 11: Replace the original three screws on the top of the light.

How it Works

During daylight hours, the sun charges the battery in the Solar Round Decking Light which then powers it after dark. The Solar Round Decking Light illuminates automatically at dusk and switches itself off automatically at dawn.

Changing the Batteries

- 1: Unscrew the three screws on the stainless steel surround and remove it.
- 2: The insert inside can now be removed.
- 3: Turn over the insert and remove the four screws.
- 4: Remove the rubber seal.
- 5: Replace the batteries with rechargeable AA NiMH batteries
- 6: Recycle old batteries
- 7: Reassemble light unit

Please note:

It is essential that the Solar Round Decking Light casing is completely flush to the ground once installed. If the light sits above ground

level it can become a trip hazard. Please take extreme care before creating a hole in your property. There may be hazards underground

such as cabling or pipes which could cause serious injury if damaged. The Solar Centre advises seeking the advice / services of a professional when installing the Solar Round Decking Light.
