



Ensure your solar panel is South facing or as near as possible



Clean your solar panel from time to time



Do **NOT** place your solar panel in shaded areas.



Please read these instructions carefully before installing your light.

Before installing your Lincoln Solar Decking Light please consider the location and shadows created throughout the day that fall upon the solar panel. Any shade may impact upon performance of the lamp at night.

Installation

- 1. Leave your light in your intended installation location for at least a few days to observe the amount of light reaching the solar panel by day and ensure you're happy with the runtime at night before installing the light.
- 2. Once you're satisfied the location is satisfactory mark and drill holes using the light as a template.
- 3. Depending on the material you're fixing the light to the wall plugs may not be needed but always seek the advice of a professional if you're unsure.
- 4. Screw the light down securely so it's held firmly in place.

Operating Instructions

In order to achieve a high standard of water proofing (IP68) the Lincoln is supplied without an on/off switch. Because of this the light will come out the box with flat batteries. If the light is only charged for a short time on the first day the first nights run time will be reduced accordingly.

Troubleshooting

If the light doesn't operate then try covering the solar panel with a towel or similar. This rules out other sources of light hitting the solar panel and tricking it into thinking it's still day time.

Trial the light in a more sunny location, the more light that is absorbed by the panel by day, the longer the light will run for at night.
