Bath Solar Wall Lights

User Guide

Thank you for choosing The Solar Centre's Bath Solar Wall Lights. Please read these instructions carefully before using your light.

Always take care when setting up your Bath Solar Wall Lights especially when you are situating them in high places.

Installing your Bath Solar Wall Lights

Before installing your lights think carefully about how much sun will be able to reach the solar panels in your intended location. South facing walls are always best but look out for trees, buildings, hedges, fencing, etc that may cause shadows throughout the day and reduce the performance of the light in the evening.

- 1. Remove the screws from the front of the light
- 2. Remove the angled bracket from the base of the light
- 3. Screw this into the wall with the screws and rawl plugs provided.
- 4. Once the angled bracket is securely attached to the wall put the light in place and tighten the screws to the front of the light to hold the light in position.

Using your Bath Solar Wall Lights

Locate the on / off switch which is situated on the underside of the top of the light and move it to the On position. Once dark the light will operate automatically and run until dawn or until the batteries are empty. The solar panel on the light will charge the batteries the next day for the process to repeat night after night. You can turn the light off at any time with the switch. **Please note the light will not charge with the switch in the off position**.


Maintenance:
