

YORK SOLAR BOLLARD LIGHT



Ensure your solar panel is South facing or as near as possible



Clean your solar panel from time to time



Do **NOT** place your solar panel in shaded areas.



Do **NOT** charge behind glass

Please read these instructions carefully before installing your light.

Before installing your bollard light please consider the location and shadows created throughout the day that fall upon the solar panel. Any shade may impact upon performance of the lamp at night.

Installation

1. Drill holes using a 12.5mm (+/- 0.5mm) drill bit
2. Insert fixing bolt and place the bollard so the screw thread protrudes above the base.
3. Add washer, locking washer and finally nut onto the screw thread.
4. Tighten the nut securely to hold the bollard upright
5. Add the cap to the nut to finish the installation.

Operating Instructions

The York is a motion activated light that illuminates when motion is detected and turns off approximately 20 seconds after motion ceases.

After dusk turn the light on using the supplied pin after giving the light up to 5 days to get a good base charge into the batteries.

Troubleshooting

If the light doesn't operate then try covering the solar panel with a towel or similar. This rules out other sources of light hitting the solar panel and tricking it into thinking it's still day time.

If the light still doesn't pickup motion let the light charge for 5 days to get a good charge into the batteries.
